# From the East Brethren,

My brothers, after a long summer break, we are again coming together in the closing months of an unprecedented year, with many unprecedented challenges. As I am sure I share the sentiments of many of you, I miss seeing you face to face and enjoying our time in lodge. Your officers and I

In light of Most Worshipful Louis J Castle's Edict No. 6, wherein he states,

"Lodge Masters may conduct Stated Meetings and Called Communications providing they carefully follow their current county restrictions, document the compliance in the Lodge meeting minutes, require all attendees to property wear face coverings at all times with no exceptions, practice social distancing, and disinfect all surfaces and objects between use"

I have proceeded forward with plans for Sandy Valley to meet. Additionally, I want to highlight an additional statement from our Worshipful Grand Master...


"Under this most recent guidance, we do not want to be responsible for drawing members from differing risk levels together."

Gentlemen, we are discussing the mortality of our brothers here. I cannot put my concerns more plainly and direct that stating the following... the decisions we make as a lodge, and the direction I provide as the Master of this Lodge, can have a direct impact on the life, or death, of a brother. As I type these words, COVID-19 is a very real threat, with no viable defense or vaccine, that can be carried by a person without symptoms or signs. Considering the location and manner in which we meet, I have no way to ensure we can meet the requirements of the Grand Master's edict (sanitize all surfaces in Worshipful Brother George's home and hanger) or, more importantly, ensure we do not place our host, or another brother in harms way. Therefore, I am canceling the in person stated meeting at Sandy Valley on September 12<sup>th</sup>. Our September 12<sup>th</sup> meeting will be held

virtually in the same manner as our previous meeting. I invite all of you to please follow the instructions to join the virtual meeting, which will be provided in another e-mail, on September 12<sup>th</sup> at 0900. Additionally, the other officers and I are diligently working on an alternative meeting location which I hope to have additional information to share with you all in the near future. My ultimate goal is to have a location, which we can safely meet and be in compliance with the Governor's orders and the edicts of our Grand Master, before the end of the year. I understand there will be strong opinions on both sides of this arguments, and I am open to having a constructive conversation with all of you, but I hope all brothers can agree that the life safety of our brothers must be paramount during these times. Please be safe, I hope you all had a safe and enjoyable summer, and I hope you see you all soon.




From the South Brothers,

## **ANNOUNCEMENTS AND EVENTS**

#### FROM THE CENTERS FOR DISEASE CONTROL AND PREVENTION RE: COVID-19:

#### **KNOW HOW IT SPREADS**

- There is currently no vaccine to prevent coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19).
- The best way to prevent illness is to avoid being exposed to this virus.
- The virus is thought to spread mainly from person-to-person.
- Between people who are in close contact with one another (within about 6 feet).
- Through respiratory droplets produced when an infected person coughs or sneezes.
- These droplets can land in the mouths or noses of people who are nearby or possibly be inhaled into the lungs.

#### TAKE STEPS TO PROTECT YOURSELF

- Illustration: washing hands with soap and water
- Clean your hands often
- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds especially
  after you have been in a public place, or after blowing your nose, coughing,
  or sneezing.
- If soap and water are not readily available, use a hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol. Cover all surfaces of your hands and rub them together until they feel dry.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.

#### **AVOID CLOSE CONTACT**

- Avoid close contact with people who are sick
- Put distance between yourself and other people if COVID-19 is spreading in your community. This is especially important for people who are at higher risk of getting very sick.

#### TAKE STEPS TO PROTECT OTHERS

- Stay home if you are sick, except to get medical care. Learn what to do if you are sick.
- Cover coughs and sneezes
  - Cover your mouth and nose with a tissue when you cough or sneeze or use the inside of your elbow.
  - Throw used tissues in the trash.
  - Immediately wash your hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. If soap and water are not readily available, clean your hands with a hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol.

- Wear a facemask if you are sick
  - O If you are sick: You should wear a facemask when you are around other people (e.g., sharing a room or vehicle) and before you enter a healthcare provider's office. If you are not able to wear a facemask (for example, because it causes trouble breathing), then you should do your best to cover your coughs and sneezes, and people who are caring for you should wear a facemask if they enter your room. Learn what to do if you are sick.
  - If you are NOT sick: You do not need to wear a facemask unless you are caring for someone who is sick (and they are not able to wear a facemask). Facemasks may be in short supply and they should be saved for caregivers.
- · Clean and disinfect
  - Clean AND disinfect frequently touched surfaces daily. This includes tables, doorknobs, light switches, countertops, handles, desks, phones, keyboards, toilets, faucets, and sinks.
  - If surfaces are dirty, clean them: Use detergent or soap and water prior to disinfection.
